INFORMATION FOR UNB PTSU MEMBERS - ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS

Article 41 of your PTSU Collective Agreement addresses UNIVERSITY CLOSURE AND ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS. Negotiated in 1st Collective Agreement bargaining – before COVID roared across the globe! – this Article addresses adverse weather procedures for employees working on-campus. What no one ever anticipated was the number of employees working from home due to COVID. During recent adverse weather, questions arose from PTSU Members in Saint John about how to apply Article 41. This is the advice your Executive Board gives you as a PTSU Member: Employees currently working from home will work normal hours, regardless if the Saint John and/or Fredericton campus is closed or curtailed. Employees currently working on either campus – who are able to work remotely – should do that. Employees who work on either campus – but are NOT able to work remotely – should not arrive on-campus until it is open. These employees, however, will be expected to arrive on the campus when it does reopen.
